Treasurer Maureen reported that we had a bank balance of \$13,884.00 and petty cash of \$45.30. We recently paid our GST bill of \$817.00.

The Committee considered a request from a member to install a number pots to create a vertical garden on the northern fence. The Committee did not support the request because of concerns about the safety of the concept as the pots may impede walkway at head /body height and fall off due to their weight, and, the pots were likely to dry out during the hot Summer months.

Planning for Open Day continues. The Committee approved purchase of a 3m pop up shade. Printing of promotional flyers is being organised for members to deliver in late September.
