Paul reported on the Committee's work during the year and our continued strong relationship with Council. He congratulated all members on their efforts at the Garden including our win at the

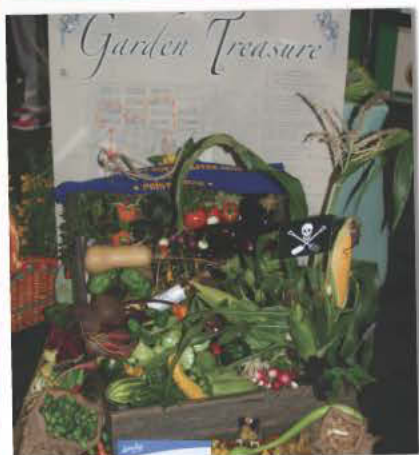
Easter Show and a very successful Open Day.
